A VOYAGE TO MEDICINE IN ISRAEL

B.SC. ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONICS ENGINEERING

The B.Sc. Electrical and Electronics Engineering program combines a curriculum devised by world-renowned faculty with professional practicums in Tel Aviv, one of the world's premiere high-tech R&D hubs. This four-year program offers eight specialization tracks including electrical devices, electro-optics, control systems, bio-electronics, power engineering, telecommunications, signal processing and computer systems.

The scholarship exempts the students from all tuition fees for the duration of their studies. The scholarship does not include application fee, airfare, dormitories, or food.

B.A. LIBERAL ARTS

This unique multidisciplinary program focuses on the humanities and social sciences. The three-year course of study provides students with a strong liberal arts education while empowering them to succeed in an increasingly complex and fast-changing world. Alongside the core liberal arts curriculum and electives in a variety of fields, students choose a major in Middle Eastern studies, philosophy, literature, Israel and Jewish studies, French studies, psychology and psychoanalysis, or communication and digital culture. EXECUTIVE PROGRAMS DIPLOMA STUDIES

Advanced Epidemiology and Preventive Medicine

June 29–July 11, 2014

The Advanced Epidemiology and Preventive Medicine summer program offers intensive courses on a variety of topics. Most of the courses last for one week and students may attend a maximum of two courses per week.

The courses are as comprehensive as those given in the regular academic term and will be taught in English by world renowned faculty from Johns Hopkins University (JHU), Harvard University (HU), Tel Aviv University (TAU), University of Maryland (UMB), University of British Colombia (UBC), and other institutions.

Food Safety & Security

July 6–18, 2014

The Summer Institute in Food Safety and Security provides students with a multidisciplinary understanding of global food security issues. Intensive theoretical and lab courses will be taught by leading experts from Israel and around the world. The courses will meet the growing need for a new generation of well–rounded academics and policy makers, who have expertise in a specific field, with broad knowledge of biology, public health, law, international development, and more.

Homeland Security Executive Certificate

March 9–15, 2014

September 14-20, 2014

The innovative Homeland Security Executive Certificate Program is open to security professionals who are responsible for critical infrastructure, commercial properties, government facilities, law enforcement, and other high–risk locations. Jointly developed by ASIS International, ASERO Worldwide, and Tel Aviv University, this seven–day course provides a thorough examination of homeland security challenges, including critical infrastructure protection, jurisdiction matters, and protective countermeasures.

Lahav Executive Education, Recanati Business School and TAU, aim to train and develop Chinese government officials, executives, entrepreneurs, academics and talents from The People's Republic of China, its provinces, cities and a vast high technology industries.
